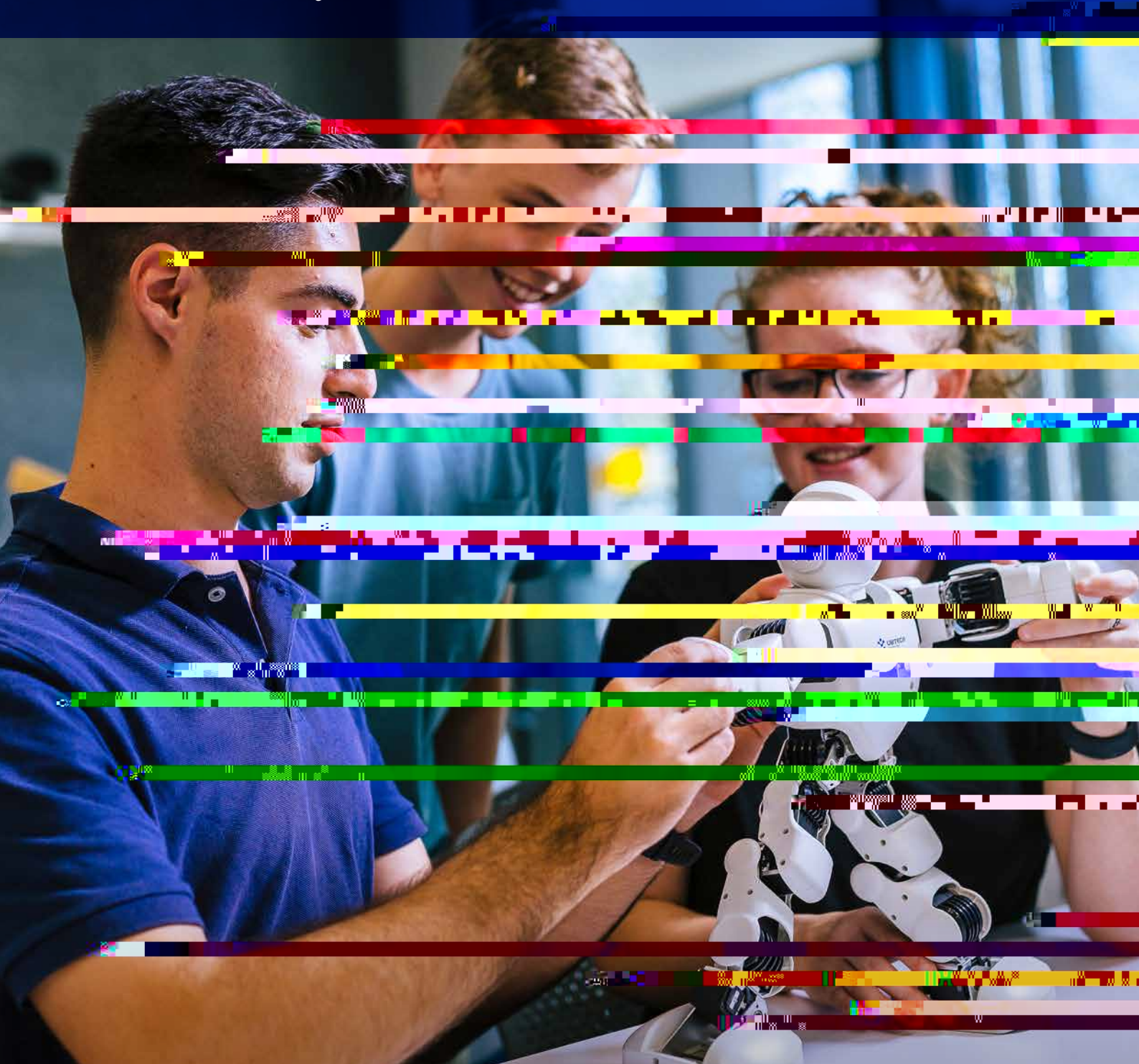

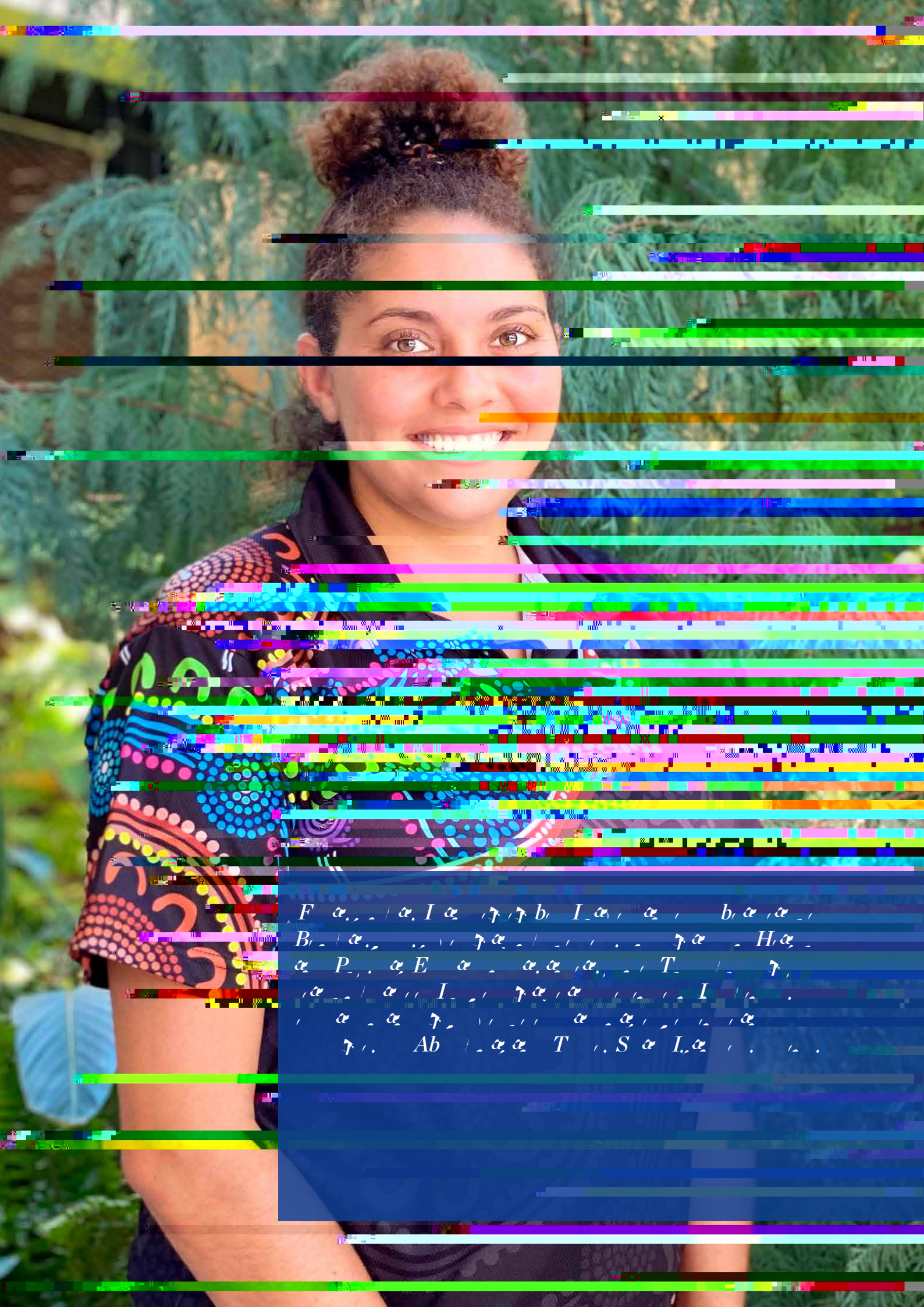




Bachelor of Education (Secondary)
