Appendix 2: Checklist Terms of Reference of an Investigation Panel

The Designated Officer (DO) will provide the Terms of Reference for an Investigation Panel. The Terms of Reference should include:

The date the complaint was received, the name of the complainant (where appropriate) and a brief description of the matter	
Name of the respondent and a clear statement of allegations	
A statement that the Panel is duly constituted in accordance with Managing and Investigating Potential Breaches of the Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research (Research Code) Procedure.	
List of the Panel members	
A detailed outline of the scope and purpose of the Panel, which may include the following:	
to investigate the matter	
 to ensure that procedural fairness is afforded at all stages in the process to all involved 	
where possible, to maintain the confidentiality of all persons involved	
to consider the protection of all involved	
to review the allegations	
to review the responses to the allegations provided by the respondent	
 to review the preliminary assessment report (including any external expert advice) 	
to identify and gather any other relevant evidence	
to interview the relevant parties	
 to consider the evidence in the context of the principles and responsibilities of the Research Code 	
to make findings in accordance with this Procedure	
to provide a report to the DO in a timely manner	
A statement about the secretariat support to be provided	
An indicative timetable for the conduct of the investigation
