Students must complete a professional experience placement as part of the program. The placement is supervised by a qualified dental professional. Students must meet the requirements for the placement, including having a valid Australian visa and a criminal record check.

Students must be vaccinated against certain diseases before starting the program. The required vaccinations are listed in the program handbook. Students must provide proof of vaccination to the university.
