

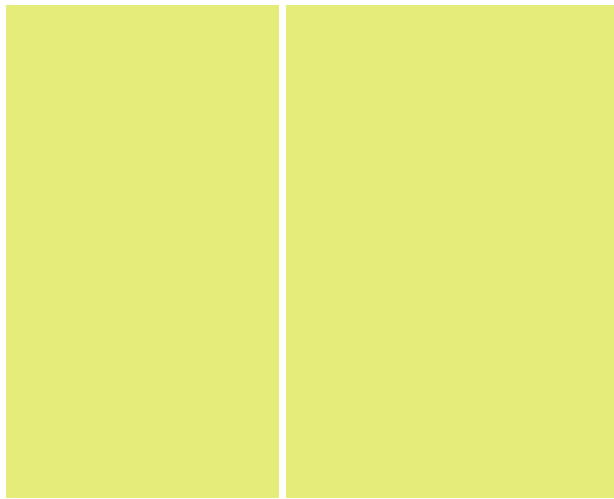

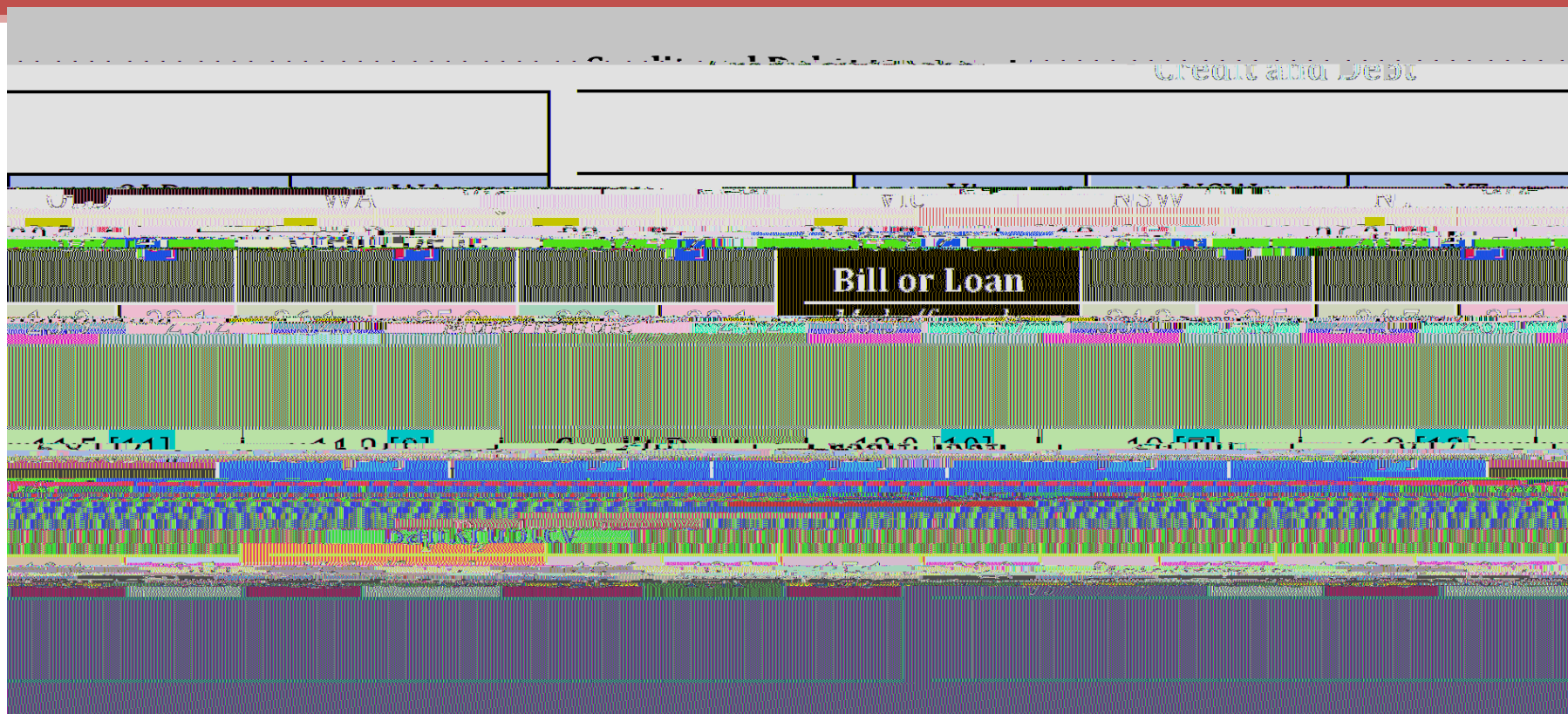
- (1) Indigenous legal needs assessment: priority civil and family law issues
